

## Details of National Team Meeting – 1/11/2012

- Location-Greensboro Aquatic Center-Greensboro, NC
- Dates of Meet- Monday, April 2, 2012 -Thursday, April 5, 2012
  - Prelims in morning
  - Finals at night
    - 30 Swimmers per event make it back
    - All swimmers are required to come back for finals
  - Time Trials in afternoon
    - Have swimmer talk to Adam about what events they should time trial if any
- Hotel- On SJAC Web Site under Meets and Travel info. Please book rooms now
  - Hotel offers breakfast
  - Hotel does not offer a shuttle to and from the airport
- Swimmers required to be in the lobby of the hotel and ready to go to practice (in Greensboro, NC) on Saturday, March 31, 2012 at 4:30pm
- Swimmers will also have practice on Sunday, April 1, 2012 (In Greensboro, NC). Time to be determined.
- Swimmers are required to be at finals on Thursday night and cannot leave early to go home.
- All travel arrangements and costs to and from NJ are the responsibility of the parent
- Parents are responsible for their own transportation to and from Hotel/Aquatic Center
- Parents are required to chaperone their children and if the parents are not attending the meet they need to get a parent to agree to chaperone their child. Coaches are not chaperones. If you have someone else chaperoning your child please notify the coaches of the details.

  - Lunch is the responsibility of the swimmer and/or parent
  - We will be feeding only the swimmers at night
  - Per the coaches we will be focusing on pizza and pastas for the swimmers and not a wide variety of foods
  - Each night a group of parents (4-5) will be assigned to help feed the swimmers. They will have to pick up the food, set up for dinner, and clean up after dinner. If a parent cannot make their assigned night they must work out either a replacement or talk to the parents in their group and work it out.
